Waheguru Ji Ka Khalsa, Waheguru Ji Ki Fateh!

On 3 Apr 2020, the Multi-Ministry Taskforce introduced several more measures to curb the spread of COVID-19 in Singapore. For religious institutions, all religious activities that were previously subject to no more than 10 persons, will now be fully suspended from 7 Apr 2020 till 4 May 2020.

In essence, Khalsa Dharmak Sabha will be **closed to the sanggat** from 7 Apr 2020 onwards until further notice.

While the Gurdwara will be closed to the sanggat, we have been graciously allowed to continue with the take-away langgar sewa. Hence, Khalsa Dharmak Sabha will continue serving langgar at the entry gate.

We are working with the various members of the sanggat, who usually come for langgar, to appoint representatives to collect on their behalf, and at segregated timings, so as to reduce the flow of people coming to the Gurdwara during this period. Even then, should there be a queue for the langgar, the sanggat is reminded to maintain a 1 metre separation from each other and follow the floor queue markings in front of the Gurdwara. The sanggat is reminded to follow the guidance and instructions of our Sewadars on duty.

In addition, the restricted collection timings will remain as per follows:

(a) 0700 - 0900, (b) 1130 - 1330, and (c) 1900 - 2000.

While the closure of the Gurdwara is disruptive, it is a necessary measure to slow the spread of COVID-19, and protect Singaporeans. The sanggat is strongly advised to **Stay Home (to) Stay Safe**, during this critical period. Through our collective efforts, and with Guruji's kirpa, we can keep Singapore safe from COVID-19.
